**MORRISON UTILITY SERVICES WINS AMP5 FRAMEWORK AGREEMENT FOR
WATER NETWORKS WITH YORKSHIRE WATER**

Morrison Utility Services, the leading service provider in the utilities sector, has been awarded Yorkshire Water's AMP5 Framework Agreement for Water Networks in the North and East of its region.

The Framework Agreement, part of Yorkshire Water's AMP5 Capital programme, is set to run for five years with the option of a five year extension and is worth in excess of £120 million for the full 10 year term.
