

## Network Term Contracts

National Grid

North London and East Anglia

Term: 5 years (until 2008)

Value: £100m



In parallel with the sale of four gas distribution networks, NGG re-tendered their Term Contracts for the retained network areas.

The scope of work included in the new contracts includes:

- Policy and mains replacement, connections, emergency and repair works
- Reinstatement of both contractor and NGG DLO works

Connections work was reintroduced to the core scope from 1st July 2003, having previously been undertaken under a separate contract by Fulcrum Connections.

Morrison was awarded Term Contracts for East London and East Anglia areas for an initial period of three years, with an option to extend for a further two years. We were subsequently requested to take over the West and Central London areas.

The contracts were initially mobilised with 28 main-laying teams, 21 reinstatement teams, nine Technical Service Engineers (TSE) and a management / administration team strength of 21 personnel. Primary offices are based at West Horndon near Basildon, Hitchin and Slough, with an operational depot at Colchester. A collaborative approach between Morrison, NGG, their suppliers and Alliance contractors ensures that NGG business objectives and targets are met.
