

## Water Distribution Network R & M and Permanent Reinstatement

Thames Water

South London & the Provinces

Term: 5 years (until 2009)

Value: £20m per annum



The area of work is South London, between the River Thames and the M25 to the west of London and the Provinces. Morrison operates out of local sites to optimise resource availability and reduce travel.

Morrison has worked in this area since 1994 and secured a ten-year framework contract in 2004 for the continued provision of network maintenance services.

The contract scope encompasses all elements of maintenance relating to mains, service and associated street furniture.

Repair work is essentially reactive and focused on maintaining water quality and network sustainability. With the upgrade of the Thames Water Network, we are also undertaking replacement work on the ageing Victorian mains.

Planning and enabling works are undertaken to ensure the challenges of working in and around London are managed effectively to ensure first time completion of works wherever possible.

Highway liaison and streetworks management are a critical element of the operation and we have a dedicated streetworks team to co-ordinate all such activity.

Our workforce is multi-skilled and we employ an extended supply chain to manage peaks in workload and deliver projects to time, cost and quality.
